

Horse Harmony 2

Duration: 3-5 days

Age group: 18+

H2 is taught on a 1:1 basis. It is our advanced course and you will have to be confident in your own abilities practised during H1 to join.

I will work with you and your horse to enhance your overall communication and understanding of each other, building on the knowledge gained during H1.

Horses inherently already know the things we will ask of them during our sessions. However, they may never have had a chance to practise them, due to our often conventional ways of raising and keeping horses isolated from each other.

Equines in a natural setting learn from their parents and peers as they spend time in a 24/7 herd environment.

Horses raised under different circumstances have a tendency to create avoidance patterns to cope with human interaction they are confused or unhappy about.

We will have to communicate to the horse during H2 that some of these patterns no longer serve them. This requires awareness, persistence, and consistency.

Course Content - Harmony 2

- Reinforce and practise skills learnt during Harmony 1 with regards to your own horse
- Learn the importance of movement and handling of horse's feet
- Learn more techniques to particularly help you deal with your own horse's needs
- Work on developing a new level playing field between you and your horse
- Find out about the sensitivity and energetic awareness necessary particularly with regards to your own horse
- Practise how to have a directed silent conversation with your horse every time you meet
